

Please find below some guidance and advice on how we may all receive Communion safely during this Coronavirus pandemic

Please do not attend church if you are experiencing any of the symptoms of Covid-19 such as a high temperature or a new continuous cough.

The entrance to the church is clearly marked and there is a one-way system in operation. There is a separate door for entry and exit.

On entering the church you must sanitise your hands.

Please collect an order of service, which was prepared over 72 hours ago, please take it away with you to dispose of.

Please sit 2 metres apart unless you are from the same household or in a 'bubble'.

Sadly, we cannot sing in church yet.

Communion

- Communicants will receive in one kind only, with no sharing of the common cup.
- The Priest will sanitise their hands before administering the consecrated bread .
- Communicants should not use the altar rail but stand at a point in front of the altar 2 metres apart, forming a queue down the aisle.
- Communicants should sanitise their hands at the hand sanitising station just before receiving communion.
- Communion will be administered in silence, the wafer being dropped into the hands of communicants, should Priest or communicants hands touch both should sanitise their hands immediately.

We are sorry that we cannot serve refreshments at the moment.

As you leave the service today, please follow the 'Exit' signs and leave via the Dukes porch, taking your order of service with you and sanitising your hands as you leave.

Thank you for worshiping here today – may God Bless you and those for whom you have prayed.
