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Foreword

This catalogue is not intended to be a history of the church graveyard. The information contained herein was collated in 2012 in an attempt to restore the records lost in the church fire of 1877. The Parish cemetery, which lies off the Theale road to the north of the church, is not covered by this catalogue.

The earliest grave recorded is from 1532, William of Willistrewe (Plot A40) on the north side of the church, with several of the Edgcombe family in the 17th Century on the south side. The most recent lie in Plot D to the west side.

There are several Listed gravestones which are of particular interest due to their unusual engravings and designs.

Within our church there are many memorials, most notably the Tremayne Memorial in the Lady Chapel, but also others to former rectors and members of the military who died in foreign fields.

Most of the gravestones record individuals and families who lived and died in the parish. Some individuals were long-lived: 99 years in 1744; 102 in 2010 and 111, Plot B49). Some were only a few months old.

Other gravestones relate to mining disasters or cholera outbreaks, with some families losing several members within a few months. Some come from neighbouring parishes; others from far afield such as Gloucestershire or Lincoln's Inn Fields in London, whilst others were from closer at hand, in North Devon or Cornwall.

It has been interesting to note how the spellings of both family names and places have changed over the centuries.

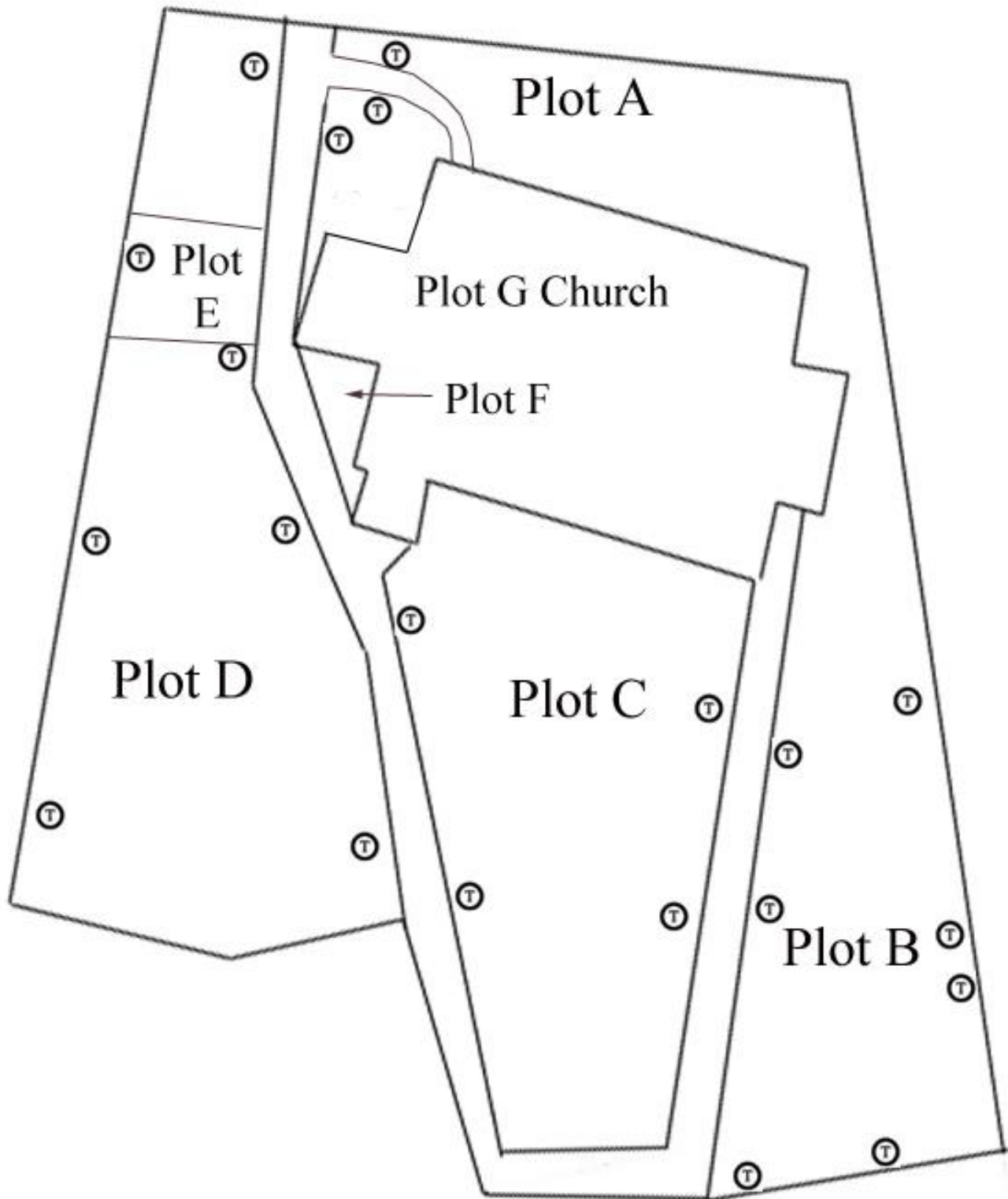

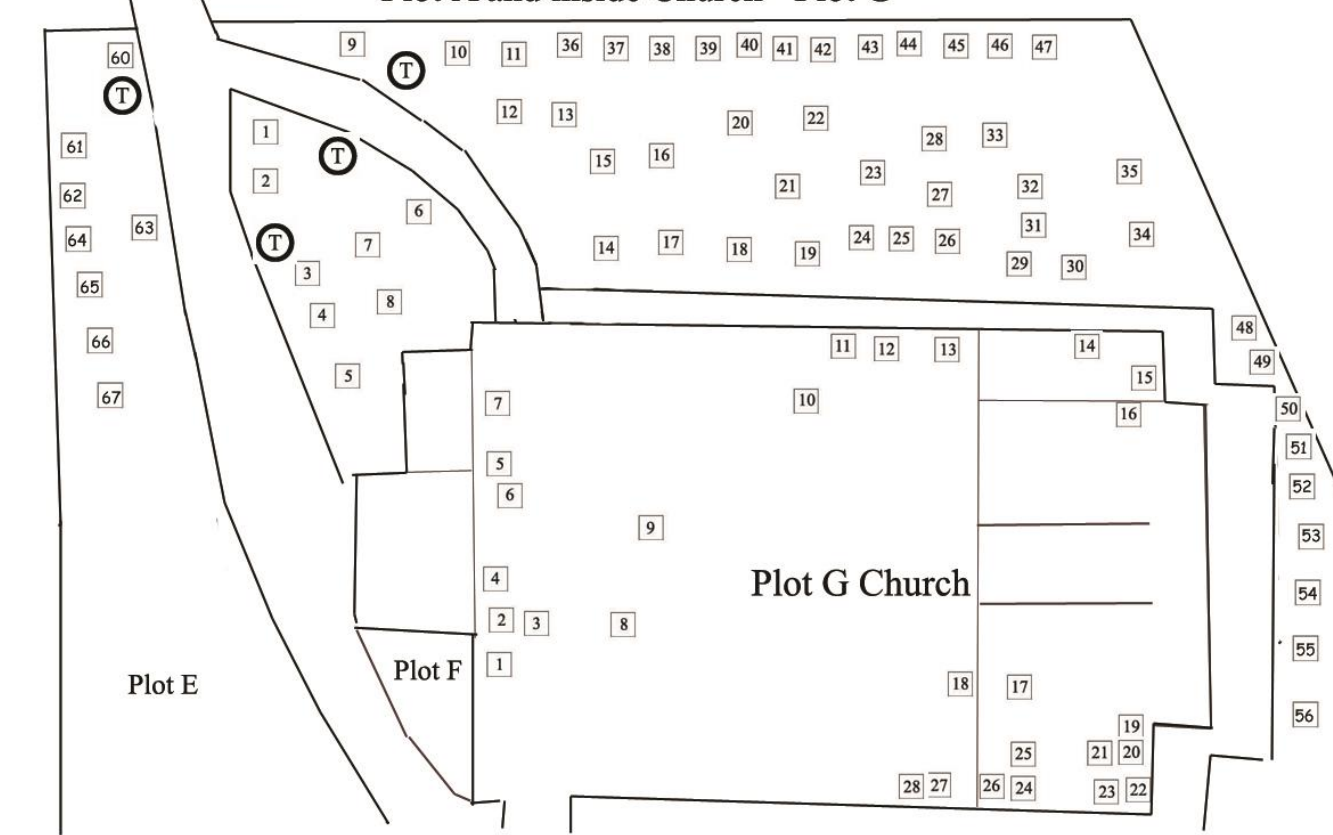

GRAVESTONES PLOT A

1. Facing big path at the west end of the Church.

In loving memory of Caroline Adela Mill died at Holwell April 13 1878 aged 85 years

Also Maria Louisa Mill died June 30 1881 aged 20 years

Thy will be done

Also of Lucy Emma Mill died January 1834 aged 30 years.

2. Facing small path leading from the back gate to the north door

Sacred to the memory of Edward Marshall Captain RN died at Camplehay November 16th 1862 aged 45 years.

3. Plot surrounded by iron railings

In memory of Walter Weeks of Hurditch who died January 15th 1857 aged 89 and

Elizabeth his wife who died February 1st 1849 aged 80.

Also of Ann, their daughter who died January 21st 1855 aged 51.

And Henry their grandson, son of Thomas Weeks who died May 24th 1837 aged 2.

Also of Rhoda, daughter of Thomas Weeks who died September 3rd 1852 aged 16.

And Walter, son of Thomas Weeks who died March 12th 1864 aged 23.

Also of Elizabeth wife of Thomas Weeks who died October 7th 1878 aged 75, and of the above named Thomas Weeks who died February 12th 1886 aged 83.

4. Sarcophagus surrounded by iron railings. (This horizontal stone was very worn and therefore very difficult to decipher. The following was all that we could with certainty ascertain.) (Dates researched on the internet)

5. Next to the tower, uses old script.

Here lieth the body of John Baker of Woodman's-Well in this parish, yeom. He was buried the 26th day of October 1767 aged 53.

Here likewise the body of Joan the wife of the said John Baker. She was buried the 24th day of October 1770 aged 59.

Here also lies the body of John son of the said John and Joan Baker. He was buried the 30th day of September 1777 aged 35 years.

Mark this O man recorded here we lie
That age and youth at God's decree may die
Lie us too late my friends, learn to be wise
Improve with care each moment as it flies
So make your peace with God then take your flight
To us in regions of eternal light
Where Saints with joy shall all in glory shine
To celebrate their love in songs divine.

6. Facing small path from the back gate to the north door, west of the path
In memory of Betsy the beloved wife of Thomas Mayjor Leamon of Willestrew in this parish who died the 20th day December 1852 aged 41 years.

7. Back to back with 6 In affectionate remembrance of Thomas Mayjor Leamon of Willestrew Park who died July 21th 1876 aged 75 years

And also of William, twin brother of the above, who died Sept 28th 1877 aged 76 years.

8. Pyramid sarcophagus, writing on the side facing the Church.

In memory of Elizabeth relict of Captain Charles Morgan R.M.L.I. who died at Belgrove October 29th 1885 aged 85 years.

9. Sarcophagus with a full length cross on the top. (Written on the panel facing south.)

Jane Maria, wife of Henry J Phillpotts the Vicar of this Parish and daur. of Sir J Ranald Martin CB died Dec 6th 1862 aged 32.

(Written on the side panel facing west)

Their infant daughter died November 20th 1862.

10. Sarcophagus with pyramid type top and surrounded by iron railings.

In the memory of Rev. William Gill B.A. & J.P. of Venn in this Parish. Born November 28 1817, died June 26 1891.

11. Near Court Barton north wall

In memory of Emma, wife of Samuel Daniel, who died May 17th 1868 aged 27 years.

12. Behind trees on the East side of the path to the North door.

In memory of Nancy Williams, the beloved wife of William Williams of this Parish who departed this life the 8th day of May 1863 aged 66 years.

How many Lord thy judgements call
So sudden unexpected fall
But fall in hope, again to rise

On wings of love, she mounts the skies.
When the archangel's trump shall sound
The Saints shall rise in glory crown'd

13. East of 11 and 12

Sacred to the memory of Thomas Botterell of this Parish who changed this mortal life in hope of a better, on the 9th day of May AD 1822 aged 66 years.

Also memory of Amy, wife of the above, departed this life January 16th 1838 aged 82 years.

16. Back to back with number 15.

In memory of John Bottrell of Rushford in this parish who was buried on the 31st day of March 1781 aged 72 years.

In memory also of John, the son of the afores'd John Bottrell of this parish. He was here buried the 28th day of September 1786 aged 42.

In memory likewise of Mary, the wife of the late John Bottrell. She was here buried the 20th day of April 1791 aged 53 years.

17. East of 14. Back to back with 18.

Sacred to the memory of Mary the wife of John Bottrell of this parish who departed this life February 4th 1859 aged 68 years.

18. Back to back with 17.

Sacred to the memory of Elizabeth, daughter of Henry and Amy Robjohn, died 13th day of April 1817 aged 22 months.

19. Southeast of 17 and 18.

Sacred to the memory of John Williams (late of this parish) who died February 4th 1838 aged 82 years.

Also of Eliz^{'th} Williams granddaughter of the above who died March 21st 1836 aged 3 years and 6 months.

20. North of 19.

Sacred to the memory of John, the son of John and Suzannah Phillips (of this parish) who was unfortunately drowned in Torch-ford, near Beer Town, November 3rd 1839 aged 24 years.

Mourne not for me, nor yet reflect
I was arrested for a debt,
A charge by Adam's fall
Tis cancelled with the Saviour's blood
And I'm at rest with Christ my god
And crown him Lord of all.

21. Slightly east between 19 and 20.

In memory of Susan Handford who died March 1st 1861 aged 19 years. She is not dead but liveth.
This stone is erected by her brother, John Handford RM.

22. Northeast of 20.

Sacred to the memory of India Laura, daughter of Samuel and Elizabeth Gregory, who departed this life the 31st October 1869 aged 8 months.

She is not gone from memory
Not from love but gone to her
Father's house above.
Suffer little children to come unto me
And forbid them not
For such is the kingdom of God.
This stone is erected by her sorrowing parents.

To the memory of Richard Hooper of this parish who departed this life the 21st day of February 1850 aged 57 years.

Also Joanna, wife of the above, who departed this life the 14th day of Jan. 1837 aged 42 years.

To the memory of Betty Horn who died November 21st 1861 aged 80 years.

Husband and three children to lament their loss.

30. Back to back with 29.

In memory of Grace the wife of Robert Davey of this parish. She was buried here the 9th day of October in the year of our Lord 1794 aged 45.

31. North of 29 and 30.

Here lieth the sleeping dust of Grace, the wife of James Williams of Waster in this parish, Yeo'n. She was buried the 1st day of May in the year 1794 aged 81 years.

I (?arewd) vain world to the deluding charms
Escape from thee I flie to Jesus' arms
So now prepare, the day is near at hand
That you before the awful judge shall stand
And redeemed by grace you then are
You shall with Jesus be in glory growing.

32. North of 31.

Sacred to the memory of James Williams of this parish who departed this life the 25th day of September 1797 aged 90 years.

Sacred to the memory of Philip Brooks (of this parish) who departed this life September 24th 1849 aged 69.

34A. Double width plot with 2 inscriptions side by side. Left=A, right=B.

Beneath are deposited the remains of Jenifer Powell, wife of Valentine Powell who exchanged time for eternity the 8th day of January 1841 aged 70 years.

Earthly cavern to the reaping
We commit our sister as dust
Keep it safely softly sleeping
Till our Lord demands our trust.

Blest to all eternity.

34B. Same headstone as 34A. On the right hand side.

Beneath are deposited the remains of Valentine Powell, late of North Brentor in this parish, yeoman. Who died the 12th day of May 1838 aged 72 years.

This was a very long stone, probably originally the top of a sarcophagus. The names and dates were written around the edge. There were 2 poems, the first was broken off at the left hand side and the smaller one was written at 90 degrees to the first but was mostly missing.
